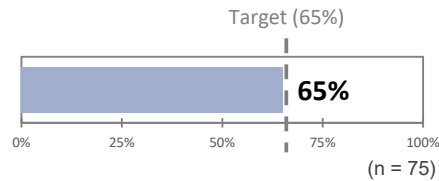

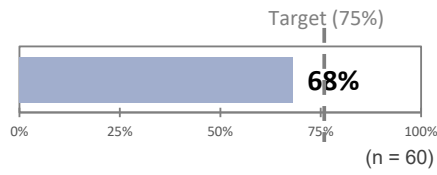

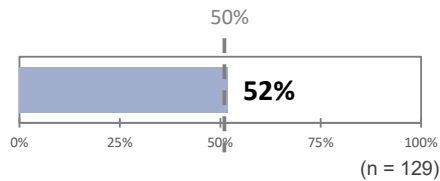
Distribution by Attendance Band

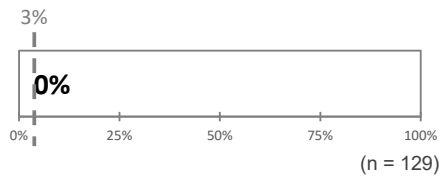

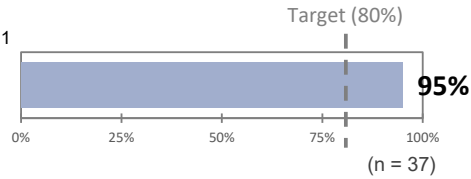

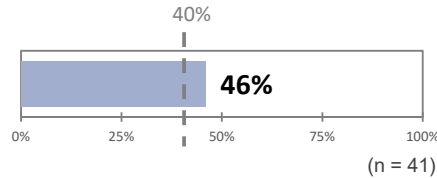

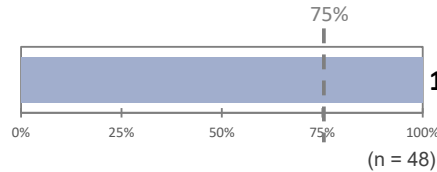
